


THIS INDENTURE, made the Eleventh day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two, between Adam Hysler, in the County of Lincoln, of the one part, and George Plott, of the County of Lincoln, and State aforesaid, of the other part,

WITNESSETH: That the said Adam Hysler sum of twenty five pounds for and in consideration of the sum paid by the said George Plott Dollars, in hand does hereby acknowledge, hath given, granted, bargained, and sold, alienated and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, alien and confirm unto the said George Plott his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land, situate, lying, and being in the County of Lincoln and State of North Carolina aforesaid

Beginning at a pine James Martin's corner going thence with his line # 50 west 54 poles to a post oak thence south 40 West 78 poles to a pine on William Lees line thence running with said line South 42 East 24 poles to a red oak Keeney corner thence running with said line South 50 West 68 poles to a Chestnut oak on # 1 line then running a new line South 42 East 120 poles to a Stake then East 128 poles to a Stake then North 178 poles to a Stake then South 65 West 70 poles to the Beginning Containing 150 acres & the same more or less being a patent of part of a 200 acres tract granted to Valentine Little by Grant bearing date bear 20th 1791 and by the said Valentine Little sold & conveyed to Adam Hysler by Deed dated 13th May 1799 Reference being had will more fully & at large appear



and all the woods, ways, waters and watercourses, and all and every the appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits of the said lands and premises, and every part thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest, property, claim and demand whatsoever, of the said Adam Hysler, of, in and to the land and premises hereby granted.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid lands and premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said George Plott his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said George Plott his heirs and assigns forever, And the said Adam Hysler

and his heirs, the aforesaid lands and premises, and every part thereof, against him and his heirs, and against the claims of all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said George Plott his heirs and assigns,

shall and will forever warrant and defend by these presents.
