consideration of the sum of Twelve Dollars and Fifty
Cents to him in hand paid by the S^d Elias Platt
the Receipt whereof the S^d Andrew Cryler doth hereby
acknowledge hath given Granted Bargained and sold
Aliene and confirmed and by these presents doth give
Grant Bargain & sell alien and confirm unto the S^d
Elias Platt and his Heirs and assigns for ever all that
Tract or Parcel of land situate lying and being in
the County and State aforesaid lying and being as
follows Beginning at a Spanish Oak on S^e Crylers
old line thence with S^e line N. 46 W. 17 poles to a
Black oak thence N. 30 E. 35 poles to a Black
Oak thence S. 46 E. 17 poles to a stake N. 30 W. 35
Poles to the Beginning containing Ten Acres and
All the woods, Ways Waters and Water Courses and
all or every the Appurtenances therunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining & the Reversion and Reversions Com-

This Indenture Made the Twenty Eighth day
of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand
Eight Hundred and Six Between Joseph Johnston
of the County of Lincoln & State of North Carolina
of the One Part. And John Brindle of the County
and State aforesaid of the Other Part. Whereby the
S^r Joseph Johnston for and in Consideration of the
Sum of Five Shillings to him in Hand paid by the
S^r John Brindle at or before the sealing and Delivery
of these presents the Receipt whereof the S^r Joseph
Johnston doth hereby acknowledge hath Granted
Bargained & Sold and by these presents doth Grant
Bargain & Sell unto the S^r John Brindle his Heirs
and Assigns for ever all them Tracts or Parcel of Lands
Situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
on the Waters of Jacobs Rivers on the South Fork and
moreover as follows. Viz. Beginning at a Pine and
Post Oak & runs S. 24 W. 88 poles to a stake then
then S. 66 E. 90 poles to a stake then N. 24 E. 54
poles to a stake then S. 66 E. 22 poles to a stake
then N. 24 W. 12 poles to a Pine then to the Begin-
ning and also one other Tract of Land joining the
aforesaid land and bounded as follows Viz.
Beginning at a Post Oak S. on Ge. Mathlons
line and runs S. 24 W. to the River Bank
