

This Indenture made the 19th day of January 303  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and fourteen Between Elias Platt of the County of Lincoln  
State of North Carolina of the one part and John Hulens  
widier of the County and State aforesaid of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said Elias Platt for and in considera-  
tion of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to him in hand  
paid by the said John Hulenswidier the receipt whereof the  
said Elias Platt doth hereby acknowledge hath given and  
granted Bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and  
by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien  
confirm unto the said John Hulenswidier his heirs and  
assigns forever All that tract and parcel of land which  
lying and being in the County of Lincoln on the waters of  
Maiden Creek Beginning at a post oak on Bolingers line  
near O'Brians corner then with his line South 42 E 160 poles  
to a Stake then North 48 East 84 poles to a Spanish Oak then  
South 80 E 60 poles to a Post oak on Bryces line then with  
his line South 45 West 210 poles to a Stake then to the Beginning  
Containing 100 acres being a tract of land granted to the said  
Elias Platt by Patent Dated December 18th 1800

Also another Tract on the waters of Maiden Creek beginning  
at a post oak Bolingers corner then South 6 East 114 poles to a  
Spanish Oak then South 54 West 120 poles to a post oak then  
South 21 East 29 poles to a Chestnut on Earnests line then  
with said line North 68 East 142 Poles to a pine Earnests corner  
then South 11 East 100 poles to a Post oak on George Platts line  
then North 40 East 130 poles to a Stake then North 43  
West 210 poles to a post oak Elias Platts beginning corner  
being a moiety of a tract containing 200 acres Originally  
granted to Adam William and Elias Platt by Patent dated  
December 8th 1802

Also another Tract Beginning at a Spanish Oak on Anarun  
Bryces line and running with said line North 46 West 47 poles to a  
Black Oak then North 30 East 35 poles to a Black Oak then  
South 46 East 47 poles to a Stake then South 30 West 35 poles  
to the Beginning being conveyed by Anareu Brycell to said  
Platt by Indenture Dated June 4th 1806 as of record well  
more fully appears to and also all the woodways waters  
and water courses and all and every the appurtenances  
thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and  
the reversion and reversions remainders rents Issues and  
profits of the aforesaid land and premises and every part  
thereof and all the estate right Title Interest claim property  
Demand whatsoever of the said Elias Platt of or out of

for and in consideration of the sum 150 Dollars to him  
in hand paid by the said John Fulerwider the receipt  
whereof the said David Kiebler doth hereby acknowledge  
hath give granted Bargained Sold Aliened and Confirmed  
and by these presents doth give grant bargain Sell Alien  
and Confirmed unto the said John Fulerwider  
his heirs and assigns forever All that tract and parcel of  
of land Situated lying and being in the County of Lincoln  
in the State of North Carolina on the waters of the Sick run joining  
land of Jacob Ingle John Peter and others Beginning at a  
Black oak in the corner and runs thence with his line  
North 10 East 106 poles to a post oak bringing a branch thence  
with his other line North 82 poles bringing another branch  
to a Post oak his other corner thence with another of his  
lines South 45 East 30 poles to a Stake and point on  
his other line thence with said line North 30 East 56 poles  
to a post oak thence North 60 West 108 poles to a Black oak  
and Hickory tree North 40 West 100 poles to a Stake thence  
South 50 West 147 poles to a Stake thence South
