

This Indenture made the 19th day of January 1803  
in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred  
and fourteen Between Elias Plot of the County of Lincoln  
State of North Carolina of the one part and John Sulenweir  
of the County and State aforesaid of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said Elias Plot for and in consideration  
of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to him in hand  
paid by the said John Sulenweir the receipt whereof the  
said Elias Plot doth hereby acknowledge hath given and  
granted Bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and  
by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien  
confirm unto the said John Sulenweir his heirs and  
assigns forever All that tract and parcel of land which  
lying and being in the County of Lincoln on the waters of  
Madden Creek Beginning at a post oak on Bolingers line  
near O'Briens corner then with his line South 42° E 160 poles  
to a Stake then North 48° East 84 poles to a Spanish Oak then  
South 80° E 60 poles to a Post oak on Cryssells line then with  
his line South 45° West 210 poles to a Stake then to the Beginning  
Containing 100 acres being a tract of land granted to the said  
Elias Plot by Patent Dated December 18th 1800

Also another tract on the waters of Madden Creek beginning  
at a post oak Bolingers corner then South 6° East 114 poles to a  
Spanish Oak then South 54° N 120 poles to a Post oak then  
South 21° East 29 poles to a Chestnut on Carnets line then  
with said line North 68° East 1142 Poles to a pine Carnet corner  
then South 11° East 100 poles to a Post oak On George Plotts line  
then North 40° East 130 poles to a Stake then North 43°  
West 210 poles to a post oak Elias Plotts beginning corner  
being a moiety of a tract containing 200 acres originally  
granted to Adam Willian and Elias Plot by Patent dated  
December 8th 1802

Also another tract Beginning at a Spanish oak on Andrew  
Cryssells line and running with said line North 46° N 47 poles to a  
Black oak then North 30° East 135 poles to a Black oak then  
South 46° East 47 poles to a Stake then South 30° West 135 poles  
to the Beginning being conveyed by Andrew Cryssell to said  
Plot by Indenture dated June 4th 1806 as a record well  
more fully appears and also all the woodways values  
and water courses and all and every the appurtenances  
thereunto belonging or in any way appertaining and  
the reversion and reversions remanndus rents issues and  
profits of the house and land and premises and every part thereof  
and all the estate right title interest claim property  
Demand whatsoeuer of the said Elias Plot of me and

the aforesaid land and premises with the appurtenances unto  
the said John Gulenwider his heirs and assigns to him only  
proper use and behoof of the said John Gulenwider his heirs  
and assigns forever And the said Elias Pott for him

every part thereof against himself and his heirs and  
against the claim or claims of all and every other  
person or persons whatsoever to the said John Gulenwider  
his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and give

of the County of Lincoln in the state of North Carolina of the  
One part and John Gulenwider of the County and State of  
said of the other part witnesseth that the said David Kiebler  
for and in consideration of the sum 150 Dollars to him  
in hand paid by the said John Gulenwider thereupon  
whereof the said David Kiebler doth hereby acknowledge  
hath given granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed  
and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien  
and confirm unto the said John Gulenwider  
his heirs and assigns forever All that tract and parcel of  
land situated lying and being in the County of Lincoln  
in the State of North Carolina On the waters of the Slick Run joining  
land of Jacob Ingles John Peter and others Beginning at a  
Black Oak Angle corner and runs thence with his line  
North 10 East 106 poles to a Post Oak bearing a branch thence  
with his other line North 82 poles bearing another branch  
to a Post Oak his other corner then with another of his  
lines South 75 East 30 poles to a Stake and point on  
his other line then with said line North 30 East 56 poles  
to a Post Oak then with 60 West 108 poles to a Black Oak  
and Hickory tree North 40 West 100 poles to a Stake thence  
South 50 West 147 poles to a Stake then South
