& sold and by these Presents both give Grant bargain
sell alien & Enfeof unto the said John Plott all that
tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being
in the County of Cabarrus & State aforesaid and on
the waters of Coldwater beginning at a black oak heavy

N^o 80° E 66 poles to a Hickory thence the other Division
