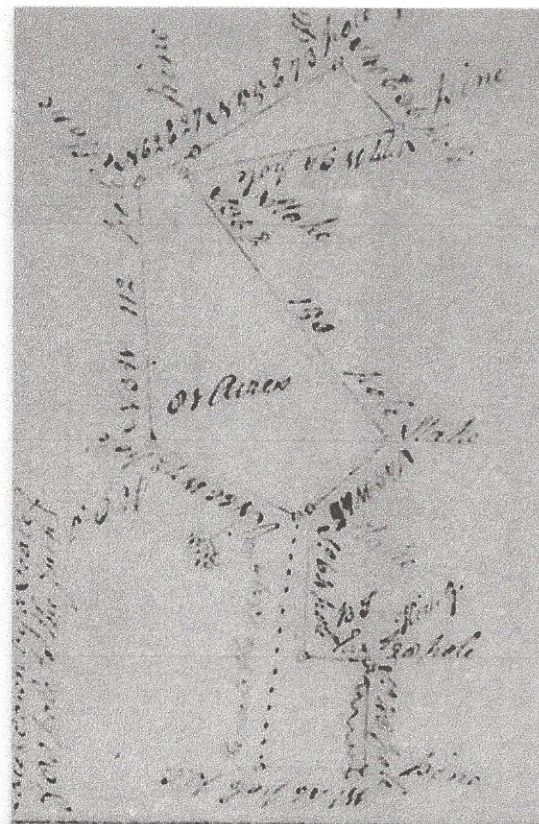

 with Charles Blackwaller entry, thence with D.
 Enters to the sixty East South seventy pole to a
 Pine; thence with D. Enters to the fifty five East
 Seventy three pole to a Hickory grub, below the



Head of a spring on Dryline thence with D. line South Forty East Thirty six
 pole to a Pine, the own Old Corner. thence with his own Old line, South Seventy seven
 West, Ninety four pole to a Stake his other corner; thence with his other Old line, south
 thirty six East one hundred and fifty pole, to another corner of his (own) new Stake
 thence with a line of his own granted land, South forty five West forty six pole to
 Stake a corner of D. Land, thence with another line of the same, south forty five
 pole to a black-jack another corner of D. granted land, thence with another line of
 D. same East thirty eight pole to a Hickory grub on D. line, thence South forty
 eight pole crossing a branch to a small Pine, thence West forty six pole crossing
 branch to a first oak, thence to the beginning. — March 15. 1785.
