

that for and in consideration of the sum

four hundred good money of S. State to him in hand paid
or assumed to be paid by the S. John Platt at and before
the sealing & signing of these presents the Receipt whereof
is hereby fully acknowledged by the S. George Platt &
he the S. George Platt hath given granted bargained
& sold and by these Presents doth give grant bargain
sell alien & enjoy unto the said John Platt all that
tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being
in the County of Cabarrus & State aforesaid and on
the waters of Catoewater beginning at a black oak Henry
Platts Corner Running thence the Division line
N. 40° E. 60 poles to a Hickory thence the other Division
line N. 13° E. 160 poles to a hopt oak sapling thence south
77° E. 59 poles to a white oak thence E. 29 poles to
a Hickory Piles Corner thence S. on west 106 poles
to a black oak and pine Piles other Corner
thence South 24 N. 94 poles to a Stake Piles

Corner thence W^t 82 poles to a Hickory Grub at the side
 of Nobody branch thence South 52 poles to a pine
 letters Corner thence W^t 91 poles to a best oak thence
 to the beginning containing by Survey one Hundred & fifty
 acres be Mullaum more or less — Together with
