 whereof is hereby acknowledged and he the said John Moyer therewith fully and  
 entirely satisfied, hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed conveyed & com-  
 firmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff convey and  
 confirm unto the said George Wilfong his heirs Ex: of assigns a certain  
 tract or parcel of land lying situate and being in the County & State aforesaid  
 on the north side of the South Fork of the Catawba River joining Henry Whitmire  
 with line, Beginning at a specimen on the bank of the River the aforesaid
