

Record of the Last Will and Testament of 185  
Rose Ann Atchison Deceased

In the name of God I now Rose Ann Atchison  
of Pala Stp Post Office Adres in the County of Hamilton  
and State of Illinois of the age of Seventy Seven years  
On the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1865 And being of  
sound mind and memory do make publish and  
declare this my Last Will and Testament in manner  
following that is to say first I give and bequeath to my  
son John Campbell of Lincoln County State of North Carolina  
1. sum of One dollar second I give and devise to my  
son James Campbell the sum of One dollar to him and  
2. said son of Lincoln <sup>with his wife</sup> third and lastly I give and  
bequeath all the rest of residue and remainder of my  
personal Estate goods and chattels of whatever nature  
or kind soever and all my Real Estate lands and  
tenements and especially all my interest in and  
to the South Half of the South West Quarter of Section Eight  
Township five South of Range five East - situated  
And lying in the County of Hamilton State of  
Illinois To my Grand Son Henry Campbell of  
Hamilton County State of Illinois whom I hereby  
appoint Sole Executor of this my last will and testament  
hereby revoking all former <sup>wills</sup> of me made  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this fifteenth day of November AD in the  
year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and  
Sixty Six Rose Ann <sup>her</sup> Atchison

The above instrument consisting of One Sheet of paper  
was at the date whereof signed sealed and  
Published and declared by the said Rose Ann Atchison  
as her last will and testament in presence of us  
who at her request and in her presence and in the  
presence of each other have subscribed our  
names as witnesses that the obove and above  
instrument consisting of One Sheet was at the date  
whereof declared to us by Rose Ann Atchison her  
last will and testament to be her last will and  
testament and she at the same time acknowledged  
to us that she had signed and sealed the same  
and we therefore at her request and in her presence  
having read said instrument <sup>to her</sup> before she made her mark  
thereto and the interlineations at fig 1 of the word sum at  
fig 2 of the words North Carolina at fig 3 of the words with  
and in the presence of each other signed our names thereto as  
attesting witnesses
